This is to Certify that John Micham Soldier in my Company in the 12th Virg^a Reg^t Command by Colo James Wood [BLWt2419-500] [illegible] the 10th day of Feb'y 1777 and faithfully served till the 10th of Feb'y 1780 the full time of his inlistment having [illegible] he was thereby Discharged from the Army of the United States given under my hand this first Febury 1785

Gentlemen Auditors I desire that you'd be so kind as to settle & give Capt. Ashby my Land warrant and pay
