William Moody a private in 1st Virginia Regiment (formerly of the 8th) having served the United States from the 15th feb'y 1776 to this date & being enlisted for the war is hereby discharged the American Army Given 15th Nov'r 1783 A Kirkpatrick Major V line [Abraham Kirkpatrick BLWt1210-300]

This man was guarding the military stores [undeciphered] when the troops was discharged.
