


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

I do hereby certify that I knew Archibald Moon as a captain in the 14th Regiment on Continental Establishment. he intered into the service in the year seventeen hundred & seventy six and Continued in the above Regiment untill the year seventeen hundred & Eighty one given under my hand this 20th day of January 1809

in the sixth Regt

Charles city County Viz
this day appeard before me a Justice for the peace and made Oath to the truth of the above Certificate and that he is a person of Credit
