October 25<sup>th</sup> 1836

The Deposition of Rachael Costin aged 74[?] years being first duly sworn deposed & saith, that Peter Moore Enlisted during the Revolutionary War from this County in the [?]th Virg'a Regiment and after serving three years returned to the County again. Further the deponent saith not.

Oct 25<sup>th</sup> 1836                      The Deposition of Southey Spady aged 7[?] years being first duly sworn deposed & saith that Peter Moore Enlisted as a soldier from this County during the Revolutionary War in the 9<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment & having served his time out returned to this County & further this deponent saith not.

Northampton Count Virginia  
October 25<sup>th</sup> 1836  
The Deposition of William Parsons aged 76[?] years deposed & saith that Peter Moore Enlisted as a soldier during the Revolutionary War from this County in the 9<sup>th</sup> Va Regiment & having served his time of enlistment returned to the County  
Further the deponent saith not
