Virginia

At a Court held for Russell County the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1846

The Court doth certify upon satisfactory evidence produced before it that Charles Morriss who was a pilot in the Virginia State Navy during the War of the Revolution, died leaving two nieces viz. Mary Adams, and Ann Jones his heirs at law. That Ann Jones died leaving one child viz. Joel Jones her heir at law and Mary Adams died in January 1845 leaving two grand children viz. Eliza Adams and Martha Ann Adams her heirs at law being the children of her deceased son William[?] Adams. The Court therefore certifies that the said Joel Jones, Eliza Adams and Martha Ann Adams are the heirs at law of Charles Morriss deceased who was a pilot as aforesaid
