I Henry Bowyer [W5859] formerly a Lieutenant in the first Regement of Light Dragoons do hereby Certify that Charles Nichols was a Soldier in the said Regement after the Consolidation of the said first Regement and the third Regement of Dragoons he having before that period belonged to the latter and from that time served under my immediate Command in the third Troop of said Regement (the Captain thereof being a prisoner of War) until the Regement was disbanded, and as well as I can now recollect he was mustered in the Rolls of said Troop as having enlisted for during the War with great Brittain. Given under my Hand the 19th day of January 1797
