I do hereby Certify that John Nichols a soldier in Colo Russells [William Russell BLWt1849-500] Detachment of the Virginia line has Served the full turn of three years for which he was inlisted and is now hereby Discharged from the Service and that he has Receiv'd his pay in Continental Currency up to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Dec'r one Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy nine Since which he has only Rec'd two Dollars in Specie from the Commissary of Prisoners at Charles Town – Given under my hand at Williamsburg this 25<sup>th</sup> Day of July 1781
