I David Nowlin Clerk of the Circuit Court of said county, do certify, that it is proven in open Court, to the satisfaction of said Court, that the within named John Palmier was a soldier in the revolution, in the Illinois Regiment commanded by Col. George Rogers Clarke [sic: George Rogers Clark VAS269]; that he served between three and four years, when the regiment was discharged, and that he never received a Warrant for the Bounty Land promised him, either on the part of the United States, or the State of Virginia, nor did he ever transfer his claims to it in any manner whatsoever. It is further proven that the said John Palmier died intestate, and that the within named Parties to this instrument are the only Heirs.
