Know all men by these presents that I Elias Pattafor of granville County & state of North Carolina for and in Consideration of Fifteen Shillings to me in hand paid by Samuel Parker of the State of North Carolina & County Afforesaid, s'd Pattafor doth bargain Loan and Assign Over my Right and title of Land & pay due me for my service in the Cont'l Army with all the poperies[?] belonging thereto the said Pattafor doth Warrant and defend from him and his heirs said land and pay due him from the publick, to the said Samuel Parker given Under my hand this 18th day of May 1784
