I do Certify that Charles Payne has [page torn] three years to [undeciphered word] from the fourth day of April one thousand seven hundred & eighty one, agreeable to the Register, Given under my hand this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March 1782      William Eskridge [W4192] Lt & Adjutant to the Gen'l Rendezvous

Point of Fork Sept'r 18<sup>th</sup> 1783

In consequence of Orders from the Secretary of War dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of August 1783 Charles Payne a private in the Virg'a Line is furloughed untill call'd for by proper Authority

Wm Johnston [William Johnston]
