Feby 2<sup>d</sup> 1781

John Perrin Soldier in the 10<sup>th</sup> virginia Regt having served the Term of His Inlistment is therefore  
discharg'd the service Tho. Ridley major [Thomas Ridley BLWt1850-400]

The Bearer is discharg'd from any further Service in the 10<sup>th</sup> virginia Regm't Given in Camp masks[?] 3<sup>d</sup>  
Feby 1781. O H Williams Colo Commd't [Otho Holland Williams]

I do Certify that John Perrin a soldier in my Company has receiv no pay Since August Last. Given under  
my Hand this 3<sup>d</sup> Feb'y 1781. Peter Higgins Lieut.

I do Certify that John perrin enlisted with me in the Continental Service for three years upon the First of  
Feb'y 1781. Michael Gush Lieut.

I do Hereby Certify that John Perrin served as a continental Soldier in my Company and in the Virginia  
Regment in the nothern army Commanded by Colo. William Davies [BLWt597-500].  
Given under My Hand this 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1784.

I do Impower Colo William [undeciphered] to Receive both the money & the Land
