This day Jessee Armstrong [possibly Jesse Armstrong BLWt2000-100] Came before me Newton Berryman a Justice of the peace for the County of Westmoreland and made Oath, that George Pritchard a resident of the County of King George, was a Soldier enlisted dureing the revolutionary war with England, under Capt Samuel [undeciphered] of the 5th Virginia Reg't and that s'd Pritchard rec'd two wounds in the Battle of Colonel Bufords defeat [defeat of Abraham Buford, Battle of Waxhaws SC, 29 May 1780] of which wounds he never recovered to the great loss of his Widdow. Given under my hand and seal the 7th day of Sept'r Eighteen hund'd and Eight
