Petition for bounty land.

The Heirs of Andrew Ray Surgeon [undeciphered]

This officer was in service in the [undeciphered] more than three years. He was a member of the Society of the Cincinnati who admitted as members, officers of the State line who had served 3 years, or to the end of the war, and none others of that line. This officer has been reported in the printed list no. 2 entitled to land for a service of three years. He may have served to the end of the war.

If your Excellency should allow bounty land, it should be for a service of three years as Surgeon in the State line
