Bedford Indiana August 16th 1841

To the Secretary of State (Va)

Dear Sir I am requested by Mr Alexander Reid, who was a soldier of the Revolution, and belonged to the Virginia line, to ask information of you concerning a land warrant issued in his name and delivered to Wm. Caperton a Lawyer of Madison County Kentucky (who has made an affidavit that the warrant is lost or miss layed) said warrant, was for one hundred acres as shown by the Affidavit of Caperton, now in my possession

Please inform me on the receipt of this, whether any such warrant was issued, and also of any other matters that may be of service to the old gentleman, particularly whether an other warrant or Duplicate can be obtained, and if so what steps must be taken to procure the same.
