I do certify that Captain Nathan Reid was appointed in the Virginia Continental Line the 7<sup>th</sup> January one Thousand seven Hundred and Seventy Seven and continued in actual service untill the first January 1783 and then retired on half pay for want of a Command.

Given a Fredericksburg May 15<sup>th</sup> 1783.
