Came Clement Richards before me the Subscriber one of the Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid, and made Oath on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God, that he enlisted on the 25 day of July 1776 under Capt. Thomas West belonging to the Virginia Line and that he was discharged in July 1779 by Brig'r General [William] Woodford, which Discharge I have lost, and that he has not received any Pay or Depreciation from the State of Virg'a since his Discharge or any satisfaction for the same, to the best of his knowledge and belief. Sworn to before me this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March 1785
