Thomas Rickard a Soldier in Maj'r Taylors [Richard Taylor S46514] Comp'y 9<sup>th</sup> Va. Reg't who was Inlisted to serve the term of three years in the Cont'l Army and has served out his time as a good and faithfull soldier and is now entitled to his discharg and is hereby discharged accordingly. Given under my hand March 11th 1780 Fort Pitt
