Virginia documents pertaining to William Riggan (Riggon) VAS4231

Mr McDonald's contract for supplying the Establishment at the Point of Fork with provisions [undeciphered word] on the 1st Instant. Shall the Superintend'ts be directed to renew the Contract with Mr McDonald, or endeavour to [undeciphered word] one for longer terms?

I Enclosed [undeciphered] the Superintendants Report respecting the ordnance he has examined.

I Alexander C. Shackelford [Alexander Shackelford S7506] of King & Queen County State of Virginia, being now in my 74th year of age, do upon Oath testify and declare, that I was well acquainted with William Riggan of said County, and that he enlisted under Capt Phillip Taliaferro and that he served in the Revolutionary war three years in succession as a private, and that I believe he was honourably discharged As witness my hand and seal this 7th day of February 1833.
