This may Certify that Daniel Rily a Soldier in the Virginia Continental Line (Colo Graysons Regiment) enlisted the first day of January 1777 for the term of three years, afterwards reenlisted in December 1779 for the War and hath received his full pay in paper money up to the thirty first [sic] day of November 1779.
