I do hereby Certify that Wm. Roane inlisted with me to serve as an Artificer in Thomas Marshal's [Thomas Marshall VAS494] regt of Art[iller]y the 6 of Sep. 1777 and that the s'd Roane serve three years in the above reg't from the date of his enlistment; he had a Discharge given him by Capt. Bradley [James Bradley VAS1889] but being much harried about in the militia had the misfortune to lose his Discharge in Consequence of which I give him this voucher so he may get whatever he may be entitled to [undeciphered] his service Ch. Roane Capt. A. [Christopher Roane X635]

The Auditor will settle my Acc't Mr. T. Graves and Deliver him my Certificate. Also the Keeper of the land office by [undeciphered] Mr. Graves have my land warr[an]t.
