Ambrose Roberts a soldier of the 2^d Virginia State Regiment having served the time he enlisted for is hereby Discharged. given under my hand at Richmond this fifth day of February 1780.

Sir please to settle my Land warrant with Mr Laurence Muse in my behalf as he is so kind to settle my Discharge For me & Will Fetch up my Land Warrant. I hope you will be so kind as to Deliver it to him Signed in my Name as dont mean to sell it & in so doing you will greatly oblige your most ob't Hum'bl Servent as it is inconvinient For me to Come. Witness my hand this seventh day of June one Thousand seven hundred & Eighty Three.
