I do Certify that Elisha Robertson enlisted as a Soldier in the 1st Virg'a Reg't prior to Jan'y 1777 & served the said Reg't until the Surrender of Charles Town May 12, 1780 at which time he was made a prisoner and died in Jan'y 1781 while in Captivity. Given under my hand this 10th of March 1785
