A Certificate from Colo. J. Allison [John Allison W4112] of Mordecai Robertson having served for three years as a Soldier in the first Virginia State Regiment and another Certificate from Robert Anderson Gent. a Justice of the said County of the said Roberts [sic] having sworn before him of his never before proving, or claiming his right to Land for the Service aforesaid, being produced & read ordered to be certified & recorded

February 3rd 1785
