AGreeable to a Resolution of Congress, bearing Date the 26th Day of May, 1783, the Bearer hereof William Robinson a Serj't for the War of the first Virginia Regiment has leave of Absence until called upon by proper authority to join his Corps, or is finally discharged. Given under my hand at Chas Town [Charleston SC] this 4th day of June 1783
