I do hereby certify that Thomas Rowlins inlisted in Bland's [Theodorick Bland VAS1859] Reg't of Horse, in the year 1776 in the second Troop commanded by Capt (afterwards Lieut. Colo.) Benjamin Temple [BLWt2214-450], & that the said Rowlins died in the year 1777, in the State of New Jersey, while in the Service of his Country; I am the better enabled to give this Certificate, from having been within a few steps of the Man when he died. Given under my Hand this 12 Day of Sep'r 1812
