

I do hereby Certify that [Sergeant] Jesse Rose of Colo John Nevils [John Nevill BLWt1595-500] Detachment of the [illegible] line, has served the full term of three years, for [which] he was Enlisted, & is now hereby Discharged from [the] service, That he has Receiv'd [several illegible words] D. Comm'y [Deputy Commissary] of Prisoners in [Char]les Town [Charleston SC, surrendered 12 May 1780]. Given under my hand at Williams[burg] this 28<sup>th</sup> day of July One Thousand seven hundred & Eighty One
