To His Excellency the Gov'r of Virg'a

Your Memorialist John S. Ross of the County of Fauquier being the sole heir at Law of John Ross and William Ross who were soldiers in the Virg'a Cont'l Line in the War of the Revolution, respectfully states that the said John Ross and William Ross he believes enlisted early in the said War, and continued to serve to the end of the same. He does not know what corps they belonged to. He has been informed that they were soldiers in the infantry. He prays that the same may be examined and if any land bounty shall be deemed due that your memorialist may receive War[ran]ts for the same & he will ever pray &c
