



I Certify that Ephraim Russel Inlisted on the 18<sup>th</sup>[?] day of January to serve in the Continental Army for three years

Given under my hand this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1782  
John Steel [BLWt2077-200] Lieut  
5<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Reg't



Point of Fork Sept'r 10<sup>th</sup> 1783

In consequence of orders from the Secretary at War dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of Aug't 1783 Ephraem Russell a Soldier in the Virg'a Line is Furloughed untill call'd on by proper authority.

Given under my hand at the place & date above  
Wm Johnston Capt Com't [William Johnston BLWt1166-300]



For a valuable Consideration I do assign to Wm Reynolds the full ballance of my pay & land together with every other emolument allow'd me as a soldier of the Virg'a line to the end of the war. Given under my 3<sup>d</sup>
