I do Hereby Certify that Jonathan Saduskey a Soldier of the [undeciphered] Virg'a Regiment was Enlisted by me the Sixth Day of May 1777 for the term of three years Given under my Hand this 29th day of October 1784
Peter Higgins [BLWt1076-200] Late
Lt 8th Vig'a Reg't

I Do hereby Certify that Jonathan Sadusky a Soldier of the 8th Virginia Regiment was in Service in May 1780 and was afterward at Charles Town [Charleston SC, surrendered on 12 May 1780] and Remained a Prisoner of war till some time in June Eighty One when he was Returned [as] Dead in the Returns of Commisary of Prisoners Given under my Hand this 29th Day of October 1784
