These are to certify that John Sale formly a souldier in the Virginia Regment has duly and faithfully serv'd the term of three years for which he was inlisted in Consequence of which and at his own request he is Hearby dischargd from any further sERVICE in the army of the United states and permitted to Return to his Home free and unmolested he having Receivd all his Bounty Pay and Clothing & definces of pay & clothing in full of all allowances and provisions made by the Congress for their troops his Receipt for which is on the Back
