King William County Ss

I do hereby certify that Nanny Sampson made oath before me a Justice of the peace for the said County that Reubin Sampson is the legal representative of George Sampson who died in the Continental Army in the year 1777 given under my hand this 29 Day of June 1789 Th's Robinson

I do Certifie that Geo Sampson inlisted in the 15th Redg't on or about Dec'r 1775 for the term of three years and served till after June 1777 and died in the sarvice of the United States

I do assign to William Bigger a Good Right to George Sampsons pay of depreciation & bounty of land due for his Sarvices in the Con'l army Reuben hisXmark Sampson
