Presley Sanders Serjeant of the Second Virginia Regiment having served the full time for which time he was Inlisted is hereby discharged from the Service Given Under my hand at the Camp Ramapough [Ramapo NJ] this 30<sup>th</sup> of August 1779. Wm Woodford Brig Gen'l [William Woodford]

I do hereby Certify that the above Serjiant Sanders was Inlisted in the second Virginia Contan'l Rigement pryor to the year 1777 and served to the 30<sup>th</sup> of Aug't 1779 for Which he Re'd no pay but what is incerted in the Acc't. June 26<sup>th</sup> 1783 A Parker Capt [Alexander Parker BLWt1740-300 & X874]

Sir Please to Grant A Certificate for what Land I may Be Intitled to unto Mr Joseph Sanders, and this My Note shall be your Discharge. Presley Sanders
