


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Virginia documents pertaining to John Scott VAS4379

At a Court held for Monongalia County the 13th day of August 1805 Jacob Scott personally appeared in court and made oath that David Scott is the heir at law of John Scott deceased who died in the continental servic in the 13th Virginia regiment, which is ordered to be certified to the Executive of this Commonwealth


I David Scott [S25425] late a Captain in the thirteenth Virginia Re[page torn] on Continental Establishment do certify that John S[page torn] Enlisted with me as a Soldier in my company at the time I was active as such Captain for during the revolutionary War and died while in the service.
15th November 1810

I do Certify that I was well acquainted with the within named John Scott before he enlisted as a Soldier in Captn David Scotts Company and was present when the Company Marched from Monongalia County for Pittsburg some time in the month of March in the year 1777 and I understood at that time as well as at the time of enlisting that it was for the term of three years
Dec'r 10th 1810



I do hereby Certify that John Scott was a Soldier in the revolutionary war under Capt david Scott in the 13th virginia regiment Commanded by Colo Jno Gibson [John Gibson S41578] and died on furlow early in said war Given under my hand this 24th Nov'r 1810 Jas Scott

I do hereby Certify that John Scott Was a Soldier in the Continantle Army in Capt David Scotts Company in the 13th Virginia Regiment Commanded by Collonel John Gibson Which Regiment was Redus'd and arraing'd in the Ninth, I understood that said Scott departed this life when in the servis of the United States. Given from Under My hand this 24th Day of Novem'r 1810
