



I do hereby certify that Samuel Scrugs enlisted as a Soldier in Capt. James Franklin's [VAS3633] Company of Infantry belonging to the 10th Virginia Regiments on Continental establishment and commanded by Col. Edward Stevens [VAS1922] sometime in the month of December 1776 or Jan'y 1777 for the term of three years, which term he faithfully serv'd. Given under my hand this 19th day of April 1809
