I do hereby Certify that Lieut. William Shackleford decd. [deceased] in the Continental Service on his way to head Quarters; at Alexandria in November 1777 and he only rec'd one hundred dollars in part of his waggess, Certified under my hand this 25th day of March 1784

For a Valuable Consideration, I do assign a good right & title to the bounty of land allow'd Lieut. William Shackelford, of the Virg'a Line, to William Reynolds his heirs &c for ever as witness my hand this twenty ninth day of Mar 1784 (eighty four) John hisXmark Shackelford

Ordered that it be Certify'd that John Shackleford Jr. is heir at law to William Shackleford decd who was appointed a Second Lieut. in Decemb. 1776 to Captain Thos. Thweatts [Thomas Thweatt (Thweat) S7708] Company of Continental soldiers belonging to the 14th Virginia regiment
