These are to Certify that Patrick Shannon formerly a Serj't in the [?]eenth Virginia Reg't has Duly and faithfully Served the term of Three years for which he was Inlisted in Consequence of which and at his Own Request is hereby Discharged from any further service in the Army of the United States & permitted to Return to his home free and Unmolested – he having Rec'd all his bounty pay and Cloathing & Deficiency of pay and Cloathing in full of all Allowances and provisions made by the Congress for their Troops, his Rec[eip]t for which is on the back hereof [not found] Given Under my hand at Philadelphia this 13<sup>th</sup> Feb'y 1780
