I do hereby certifie that Duke Shearman enlisted for two years in the American army on Continental establishment in the sixth Virginia Regiment and that the two years had nearly expired when I left the said Duke Shearman in the army to the Northward

Given under my hand this 21<sup>st</sup> day March 1808

I do hereby certifie that Duke Shearman enlisted in the sixth Virginia Regiment on continental establishment and that the said Duke Shearman enlisted the second time (having served two years) for three years and died at Bethlehem as I believe in the army. Given under my hand this 21<sup>st</sup> day March 1808.

I do hereby certifie that Duke Shearman enlisted as a Sargeant in the sixth continental Virginia Regiment for two years, and at the end of said term he enlisted for three years longer and before the expiration of the second time of enlistment he the said Duke Shearman died in the army. Given under my hand this 21<sup>st</sup> day March 1808.
