Chesterfield Courthouse 31st Jany 1781

I do hereby certify that garet Simpson [sic] a Solder of Capt Lapsley [Samuel Lapsley W9149] Company Colo. Nath Gists [Nathaniel Gist BLWt1874-500] Regiment Inlisteted the twenty fifth day of march 1777 to serve in the Continal army for the term of three years as appears in the muster roll of said company for the month of august 1779 in which month the said Simpkins made Prisoner at the Hook [probably Paulus Hook NJ, 19 Aug 1779. F Muir Cap & PM [Francis Muir BLWt237-300]

The above mentioned Garret Simpkins having seved the term for which he was enlisted is herby discharged from the army
