I William Figg being now in my seventy third year of age doth Certify that I was well acquainted with Capt'n Samuel Simpson who was in the revolutionary war in the Virginia state line but I do not recollect what regiment he belonged to, he marched from York and I never saw him any more until the end of the war which was upward of three years he was in service as witness my hand and seal this the ninth day of June 1832

I do hereby Certify that Samuel Simpson served three years & upwards, in the Virginia State line, during the Revolutionary War in the Capacity of Captain, & he was honourably discharged, at the close of the war.

Given under my hand & seal this 20th day of July 1832.

I do hereby Certify that Samuel Simpson was an Officer in the State line of Virginia and served upward of three years in succession in the Army of the Revolution in the Capacity of a Captain, and he was honourably discharged, at the close of the war.

I, Thomas Blasenham being now in my 70th year of age, doth certify that I was well acquainted with Captain Samuel Simpson who was a Captain in the army of the Revolution of the State line, and I knew him in the service for three years & upwards in succession and until the end of the war, and that he was honourably discharged.

It appears that Samuel Simpson a captain in the State line of the Revolutionary army received on the 23 Feb 1784 a certificate for the balance of his full pay or depreciation amounting to £290.17.0.

I certify that it appears by the Register of certificates issued to Officers and Soldiers of the Revolutionary War, for the balance of their full pay or depreciation that a certificate issued on the 23^d day of February 1784 to Samuel Simpson Captain of Artillery in the State line, for £290.17.0.
