

Joshua Singleton Sergent Belonging to the Sate Ridg't [state regiment] Haveing serv'd three years as a good Solder Being the full Time of his Enlistmen is discharged from the said Regm't and is intitled to the Benifits of the acts of Asembly By which the State garison Regem't was Raised given under my hand this 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1785
