I do hereby Certify that I Enlisted Robert Sisson, late a Serjeant in the Second Virginia Continental for three years some time in the fall of seventeen hundred & seventy six & that some time after that he enlisted for the continuance of the War, he continued with the army untill the fall of Charles Town [Charleston SC, 12 May 1780] where he was made prisoner, and that after some time he was confin'd on board a prison Ship. And he was not to my knowledge ever exchange'd untill the end of the War.
