I hereby certify that the bearer Edward Steward enlisted as a soldier in the State Artillery in August 1777, that he served faithfully for three years, the term of his enlistment, & after his term of enlistment was out, that he marched from Hillsboro [Hillsborough NC] & to this place where he was discharged.

Richmond July 23^d 1784.
