State of Virginia/ Norfolk County

At a Court held for the County of Norfolk the 15th day of February in the year eighteen hundred
[undeciphered]

Jesse Nicholson of this county came into Court and made oath that Charles Stewart formerly of this County [two illegible lines] how much longer he does not know, and he believes was afterward promoted to a Lieutenant, which is ordered to be certified.

The Court doth also certify that William Stewart, Charles Stewart and Alexander Stewart are the only [undeciphered] heirs at law of the said Charles Stewart [several undeciphered words] by my hand and caused the Seal of my Office to be hereto affixed on this Sixteenth day of August, one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, and in the 41st year of the Commonwealth.
