

This is to certify that Andrew Smith a soldier belonging to Colo Thomas Marshalls [Thomas Marshall VAS494] Reght of State Artillery was enlisted the 23rd August in the year 1777, and serv'd as a faithful and good soldier the term of three years which he was Enlisted for and is hereby discharg'd. Given under my hand this 23rd day of Aug't 1780.
