I do certify that John Thompson was a Serjeant in the 2^d Virginia Continental Regiment from the 1st day of January 1777 to the 13th day of March following, when he was made Serjeant Major to the said Regiment and continued in the said Regiment in the said Capacity until the 5th day of October 1781, when he was regularly discharged by the Board of War in Philadelphia. This I know of my own knowledge, having been an Officer in the said Regiment, and seen his discharge signed by order of the Board. Jos.
