



I hereby Certify That Francis Smith a Soldier in the 5th Virginia Regiment enlisted into the Continental Service the 11th Day of January 1777 for Three years & having served the term of his enlistment is now discharged & Commissaries on the Road are requested to furnish him with provisions till the 3^d of February 1780. Given under my hand Frederick Town the 20th of January 1780.
