


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Halifax County 25th May 1791. I do certify that Mr. James Smith the bearer hereof was a Serjeant in my Company on Continental Establishment in which capacity he continued to the end of the war. Given under my hand Nath'l Terry Capt. [Nathaniel Terry1 W3054]

I do certify that James Smith enlisted in the year 1776 for two years in Capt. Mich'l Bowyers [Michael Bowyer BLWt288-300] company which was part of the 12th Virginia Regiment. That he afterwards re-inlisted for three years or During the war and to my knowledge was in service till some time in the year 1780 when he was on his march to join the Southern Army. I was detached to superintend the Rendezvous at Staunton. Given this 31st day of Jan'y 1792
