This [may] Certify that James Smith inlisted himself under me December 8<sup>th</sup> 1776 as Solder in the 10<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Regiment to Serve for the term of Three years, and the said James Smith dec'd [died] 25<sup>th</sup> Jan'y 1778.
