

Monongalia County, Virginia, to wit.

I do hereby Certify that John Smith son of William Smith who lived in the County of Monongalia & State of Virginia aforesaid was a Soldier in my Company 13th Virginia Regiment under the Command of Colonel John Gibson [S41578] in the Continental war for three years & upwards. Said regiment was reduced to the 9th

At a Court held for Monongalia County on Monday the 14th day of October 1811:
Elizabeth Shaver, formerly wife of John Smith deceased personally appeared in Court and made oath that Mary Franks wife of Conrad Franks, Rebecca Ashcraft, wife of Levi Ashcraft, Catharine Fiersh wife of George Firsh are the children and heirs of John Smith deceased, which is ordered to be Certified.
