


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

I do Certifie that John Smith Soldier in the 10th Virginia Regiment Inlisted the 8th day of March 1777
for the Term of three years which time he served & was Discharged.

Given under my hand this the 26th Sep'r 1783
Natha'l Terry Capt [Nathaniel Terry W3054]
in the 10th Virg'a Regm't

I do Certify that John Smith serg't. enterd into the State Service in sept 1775 and continued in s'd service
till Jan'y 1777 when he inlisted for three years and continued in service till some time in March 1780
